LESS than four months after announcing their split **Charlotte Church** and **Gavin Henson** are dividing their assets, starting by putting their yacht up for sale.

They bought the £800,000 Fairline Squadron 55 yacht 18 months ago. It was a dream of 24-year-old Charlotte's to own one and they were often seen relaxing on it. But this week they put the vessel on the market – for £50,000 less than they bought it for.

Charlotte and Gavin are worth an estimated £11 million, including their £1.2 million house in St Bride's Major, Glamorgan, their yacht and a fleet of expensive cars.
